

EASTVIEW COMMUNITY FOUNDATION: SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS GUIDELINES - CLASS OF 2018



- All recipients of Eastview Community Foundation scholarships are expected to have demonstrated good citizenship and be in good standing with Eastview High School and/or School of Environmental Studies. Scholarship candidates should have no MSHSL violations, cheating or academic integrity violations, or chemical violations since the end of their sophomore year. *Candidates not meeting these criteria may provide an explanation in order to still be considered for a scholarship.*

NOTE: A scholarship applicant who is determined to have submitted false information on any part of the application is subject to disqualification.

- The application survey can be found on your NAVIANCE Family Connection account under the 'about me' tab and 'surveys to take'. This is an electronic (online) application process. You **DO NOT** need to print or submit a paper copy of the application survey.
- Under 'surveys to take' select '2018 EV community foundation scholarship'.
- **The on-line application survey must be completed by the end of the day, Sunday, February 4th, 2018. The on-line application closes at midnight. Late submissions will NOT be accepted.**
- **NO TRANSCRIPT is required.** Have your class rank, GPA, ACT and/or SAT scores available as you begin the application survey. This information is also available in your Naviance Family Connection profile & scores.
- **EVCF Scholarships:** The essay prompt for most scholarships asks you to describe your involvement for each program & how the program has influenced you as a person. Some scholarships have different prompts. An extensive list describing specific criteria for each scholarship is available at the scholarship page on the **EVCF website (www.evcf.org)** or in the **Document Library in NAVIANCE Family Connection** in the EV Scholarship Program folder.
- **SAVE YOUR ANSWERS periodically if you need longer than 1 hour to complete the survey.** Your session will expire after 1 hour if you have not changed the page. You **will** be able to **SAVE and RETURN** to the application survey later. *Click on "Save and I am Finished" once you are certain you have completed the survey (you must do this or it will not be submitted and you will lose your work!).*
- **A RECOMMENDATION letter is ONLY required if specified in the description for the scholarship.** The letter must be received by Jolene Veldhuis in the Counseling office by **3:00 pm on Monday, Feb. 5th.**
- **FINANCIAL NEED based scholarships require a copy of the front page of your STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR) from FAFSA to Jolene Veldhuis in Counseling by 3:00 pm on Monday, Feb. 5th.**
- **Applying to more than 5 scholarships?** For a 6th (or more) scholarship essay, type your name and the title of the scholarship on paper and turn in to Jolene Veldhuis by **3:00 pm on Monday, Feb. 5th.**
- **We strongly encourage you to apply for as many scholarships for which you are eligible!**
